

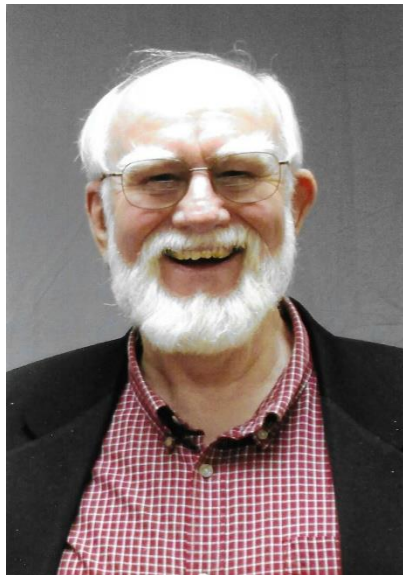
## Wanda Richert
