

Covid Safety Provisions for the 2022 TWG Roundup - last update 1/28/2022

We plan to layout a floor plan for carving seminars that maximizes separation for seminar participation seating. For example, we will attempt to place no more than two carvers per 6-foot table and not place carvers on both sides of a table. We will need to work within the constraints of available floor space, but the event hall is larger than we had in the past. Seminars with larger numbers of participants will have more floor space than seminars with fewer participants.

This is a moving target but we will continue to make adjustments as registration continues. We are required, by contract, to have our floor plans to the Hill Country Youth Event Center (HCYEC) management thirty days prior to our event for Fire Marshal approval.

The HCYEC has hand sanitizing stations located throughout the facility and also have some portable bottles that can be placed as needed. Daily janitorial service is also provided by the facility for the restrooms and for daily trash disposal in our working area. The HCYEC is a government owned facility and must abide by State and Federal regulations.

At the current time, masks are not required in Kerrville. Wearing masks is your personal choice. Please plan to bring masks if you plan to use them. Since mask requirements could become mandatory at any time, please be prepared for the possibility that masks are required. The Guild will not provide masks. If we learn masks are required prior to our event date we will inform participants.

We will update this information if we learn more details or changes.
