


# Brazoria Co. Woodcarvers

Chip Carving Class



#### Name Tag Carving



This is an example of the name tag chip carving I have been requested to lead. I will have a signup list at the May 10th meeting.

Below is the chip carving practice board I have created for carving the name tag. You will be able to signup for one that I can bring to the June meeting. However, if you would like me to bring you one to the May meeting, please send me an email so I can make them next week. These are 6" X 6" two sided basswood practice board. I am asking \$5 for each of the practice boards.





NOTE: The name tag shape on this practice board is the actual size we will be carving. You can see the number of letters that can be put on the name tag. If you need more letters, I will have to use a smaller size font. We will get your name to fit.

## TWG Website

Did you know you can add the TWG Website as an icon on your phone's Home Screen! Follow these quick and easy instructions to keep all the latest info at your fingertips.



- <u>Open Chrome and navigate to the website:</u> Open the Chrome browser and go to www.texaswoodcarversguild.com
- <u>Tap the three-dot icon (More options):</u> Located in the top-right corner of the address bar.
- <u>Select "Add to Home Screen":</u> This option will prompt you to create a shortcut for the website.
- Rename (optional): You can rename the shortcut or use the default name.
- <u>Tap "Add":</u> The shortcut will be added to your home screen.



- <u>Open Safari and navigate to the website:</u> Open the Safari browser on your iPhone and go to www.texaswoodcarversguild.com
- <u>Tap the Share button:</u> Locate the Share button (it looks like a square with an arrow pointing out of the top) at the bottom of the Safari screen.
- <u>Select "Add to Home Screen":</u> In the list of sharing options, scroll down and tap "Add to Home Screen".
- <u>Customize the shortcut:</u> You'll be prompted to name the shortcut and confirm the URL and icon. You can edit the name if you prefer.
- <u>Tap "Add":</u> Once you're happy with the name and icon, tap the "Add" button.


